(Map/graph/photograph skills, Fieldwork, Decision making)



How is the course assessed?

- Paper 1 Living with the Physical Environment (90 minutes)
- Paper 2 Challenges in the Human Environment (90 minutes)
- Paper 3 Geographical Applications (90 minutes)
- There will be regular internal assessment throughout the course so that progress can be tracked and any necessary support provided



Why study Geography at Lode Heath?


- A track record of success at GCSE Geography
