- Year 9 French: Unit 1 - Media





Topic(s) to be covered

This term students will explore the following topics: Recapping present and past tenses, TV programmes, computer activities, films, music, reading and Christmas in France. Students will develop their skills by reading and listening for gist and detail and speak and writing spontaneously with the support of the verb – opinion – reason model structure.

Assessment Procedures

- 1. Interim assessment part of the way through the unit.
- 2. Speaking assessment students will prepare answers to 5 questions in French and will answer 3 of these questions.

Homework guidance

Students will receive a minimum of one homework per week for which they will be expected to spend a minimum of 30 minutes completing. The homework will usually be to learn key vocabulary or complete listening and reading tasks on www.languagenut.com. If there are upcoming assessments, revision homework may be set.

In cases where homework has not been completed, MFL teachers may grant a day extension. If the homework is still not completed following this extension, this will result in a 25 minute after school detention.
