



Year 7 German: Unit 1 - Introductions

Topic(s) to be covered

This term students will explore the following topics: Greetings and introductions, asking and responding to 'Wie geht's?', numbers 1-31 and ages, Ich wohne and countries, alphabet and spelling names, colours and favourite colour, birthdays. Students will develop their skills by reading and listening for cognates and use simple phrases to respond to questions about themselves.

Assessment Procedures

1. Interim assessment – Students will read out some short sentences in German and gain marks for accurate pronunciation.

Homework guidance

Students will receive a minimum of one homework per week for which they will be expected to spend a minimum of 30 minutes completing. The homework will usually be to learn key vocabulary or complete listening and reading tasks on www.languagenut.com. If there are upcoming assessments, revision homework may be set.

In cases where homework has not been completed, MFL teachers may grant a day extension. If the homework is still not completed following this extension, this will result in a 25 minute after school detention.

How can you help?

Encourage your child to download the Duolingo app which supports German language learning. Student can also use the platform on which their homework is set to learn extra vocabulary. Other useful websites include www.quizlet.com and www.linguascope.com.





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At Key Stage 2...
